


## Accessing Additional Features

1. Log in to the **Training Portal**
2. Navigate to your assigned course

## Glossary Section – Overview

1. Each course section includes a **Glossary**
2. Contains important terms and definitions related to the section
3. Helps learners clearly understand key concepts
4. Can be accessed at any time during learning




## Glossary Section – Key Features

1. The glossary is regularly updated
2. Learners can add new terms encountered during learning
3. Useful for quick clarification of difficult concepts

## Downloading the Glossary

1. Click the drop-down menu in the top-right corner
2. Select Printer-friendly version
3. Download the glossary as a PDF file




## Hands-on Practice Section – Overview

1. Available after completing all documents and videos in a section
2. Designed to help learners apply what they have learned
3. Provides practical, task-based learning

## Hands-on Practice in Cellma

1. Clicking the Hands-on Practice link redirects you to Cellma
2. You will be taken to the Cellma login screen
3. Enter your credentials to begin practising tasks covered in the section



## Knowledge Check Section – Overview

1. This section is **not graded**
2. Does not affect the overall score
3. Learners are encouraged to attempt it seriously
4. Click **Check** to view correct or incorrect answers instantly



## Knowledge Check – Attempts and Review

1. Click Finish Attempt to review responses
2. Unlimited attempts are allowed
3. Learners may retry until confident with the content
